- Academia Buenos Aires has decided to temporarily discontinue offering shared housing for agents, as this options tends to be unavailable due to high demand through students.
- Academia Buenos Aires now offers a full program of medical shadowing.
- Academia Bariloche is offered only upon request as the operation of the school is outsourced.

Specifics for each product offered:

1. Inscription fee is charged "once in a lifetime". When both schools are combined, inscription fee is charged only in the first school.
2. One-way
3. Start and end dates as well as contents can be agreed freely with the school administration. 20% surcharge outside of office hours (9 am to 6 pm, Monday through Friday)
4. This course is taught in groups, with courses starting every Monday, year-round. It is the standard group course and taught in two shifts, usually from 9.30 am to 1.30 pm, exceptionally from 2.00 to 6.00 pm. Maximum 7 students per class in Buenos Aires and Montevideo. In case a student is alone in a group class, the number of hours is reduced from 20 to 10 in Buenos Aires, from 20 to 12.5 in Montevideo.
5. This course is ideal for students who on top of their group courses would like to take one-on-one classes in the afternoon. The price is a combination of intensive group prices and individual class prices. Both schools are recognized in all major Bundesländer in Germany including Hessen and BW.
6. This course is designed for students around the world who want to study Spanish from the comfort of their home or their office. It combines 4 hours of teacher-led classroom settings via zoom and 4 hours of self-study, per week. The autonomous study will be through our online platform Mi Español, which helps students exercise what they have learnt in class and helps them prepare for the following class. The platform uses a wide range of videos, audios, texts relevant to the topic studied in class and specially designed for our curriculum. It engages the students through all kinds of interactive exercises, games and tasks to resolve. Minimum number of students to open a group is 2 students. Courses on all levels A1-B1 start every 1st Monday of a month, monthly. If for some reason only one student is left in a group, the number of synchronous hours is reduced from 16 to 12.
7. Upon demand
8. This course is offered on a one-on-one basis. The duration and skill level of the course depend on what prior knowledge the participant has and of course on how much time is left before the exam. We will be happy to advise our clients and establish a specific study plan.

9. This course is a combination of the intensive Spanish (group) course and tango classes in groups (Buenos Aires only). Tango classes are taught in a partner institution close to the academy.
10. This course is a combination of the intensive Spanish (group) course and individual tango classes. Tango classes are taught in a partner institution close to the academy.
11. All courses mentioned in this document can be combined with volunteer work. Independently of your Spanish level we require students to take at least 3 weeks of group Spanish courses and commit to at least 4 weeks of volunteer work. The student's Spanish level when starting the project has to be at least B1 (good intermediate). We will send you a list of available projects upon request.
12. Oriented towards Spanish teachers of all levels of experience. Reduced prices for groups.
13. All courses offered include the possibility to do a test at the end. Our local partner university will then confirm the amount of contact hours at the academy, the level obtained and the exam grade on a 100 scale. With that signed document students can then ask for credits at their home university.
14. This course requires an intermediate Spanish level and specifically addresses technical vocabulary and the local economic context. Only in Buenos Aires, only as one-on-one tuition.
15. This course offers physicians, nurses, medical students and other health professionals the opportunity to build up a specific vocabulary and to put it into practice. This course is usually offered as a complement to regular group classes.
16. Academia Buenos Aires offers students the possibility to improve their Spanish, learn specific vocabulary and observe physicians in hospitals (shadowing). This package of three weeks includes 40 hours of group Spanish classes, 5 hours of specific medical vocabulary and role plays, 5 hours of introduction to the medical system in Argentina and 20 hours of shadowing in a hospital in Buenos Aires. Students are limited to observing interactions between physicians and patients. Possibility to express preferences for certain specialties. Consult for more details.
17. Same as #16, but with 40 hours of shadowing
18. The Farm-stay program combines taking 4 weeks of Spanish classes at Academia and staying on an estancia (large farm) outside of the city for 4 weeks. Students participate in regular farm-work, which varies depending on the season of the year. Includes homestay in the city (breakfast and dinner included) and housing at the farm with full 4 meals daily.
19. Regular program. Breakfast is light.
20. Regular program. Breakfast is light. Dinner is served 6 days per week.
21. Arrangements can be made for shared apartments in a residence with excellent amenities, for periods of 1 month or multiple (full) months. Subject to availability.
22. All academies can offer studios or larger apartments. Prices may vary strongly depending on size, location, time of the year, length of stay. Down payment required. Prices start at 1200 USD/month. Non-commissionable.
