

IELTS PREPARATION

CRICOS CODE: 092869G

Covers a wide variety of topics and situations to assist you in your everyday life. Focuses on real and practical usage.

This course is perfect if you wish to improve your ability to use English in everyday life. It is designed to cover the fundamental language skills of reading, writing, listening and speaking, while developing your confidence and increasing your understanding of English grammar and vocabulary. Your progress is monitored weekly with an assessment, and at the end of each 5-week term with an exam. If you have completed at least 5 weeks at that level and successfully pass your exam, you have a chance to move to the next level.


