

Methodology

How to apply

To receive Erasmus+ funding for your course, you must apply through your institution, school, training centre or university. Before beginning your training, you, your institution and Babel Academy of English sign a Mobility Agreement. This document sets out your learning goals, rights and responsibilities and how your training will be formally recognised. If your institution has an Erasmus+ Coordinator they will assist you with your application > Contact us if you need assistance with completing Erasmus+ documentation.

3. We sign the Mobility Agreement with your institution



4. Before arrival you get access to the E-Learning App & complete pre-course assessment

Language Requirement

Our courses are designed for staff for whom English is a second language. Participants complete language assessment before arrival. During first day registration and induction you have a meeting with a member of the academic team to assess your speaking skills and requirements - you are then placed in the class that best suits your English language level. We have courses suitable for all levels from A1 to C1.

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Specialised Training Courses



Our Erasmus+ specialised staff training courses combine professional development workshops with English language fluency sessions and social and cultural programme activities. Focus on English is a key part of courses so that you gain confidence and improve communication skills for your educational context. Through workshops, we facilitate a collegial environment where education staff can learn from one another and gain a refreshed perspective on their roles. Practical activities ensure you bring back ideas and activities useful to your institution. On social and cultural programme excursions you have opportunities to socialise and explore Ireland's rich culture and history.

Who is the course for?

Teaching staff who use, or intend to use, English as a medium for instruction.

Content

In addition to English fluency sessions, workshops cover:

- Principles of Content and Language Integrated Learning
- Lesson planning with language integration
- Creative teaching methods, tools and materials

Minimum B2 English language level

Methodology for Language Teachers

Who is the course for?

Language teachers looking for innovative methods to engage students during lessons.

- Teaching methodology and strategies targeting language learners
- Techniques for engaging and motivating learners
- Incorporating task-based activities into lessons

Content

In addition to English fluency sessions, workshops cover:

- Lessons to promote group work, collaboration and student engagement

Requirements

Minimum B1 English language level

Mindfulness in Education

Who is the course for?

Staff in educational settings who wish to bring mindfulness into their daily work practices.

Content

In addition to English fluency sessions, workshops cover:

- Strategies for integrating mindfulness into daily routines in educational settings
- Enhancing well-being through application of stress management techniques and focus on reflective practice

Requirements

Minimum B1 English language level

Presentations & Academic Writing Skills

Who is the course for?

University, training centre or education staff who want to refresh their presentation skills and hone their academic writing skills.

Content

In addition to English fluency sessions, workshops cover:

- Creating effective presentations
- Handling questions and answers
- Functional language for academic writing
- Written communication structure and sequence

Requirements

Minimum B2 English language level

English for International Office & Student Support Staff

Who is the course for?

Administrative and student support staff who use, or wish to use, English when communicating with students or colleagues.

Content

In addition to English fluency sessions, workshops cover:

- Developing functional language for communication with international students and colleagues
- Exploring strategies for effective pastoral care and support
- Answering questions and dealing with issues

Requirements

Minimum B1 English language level

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Language & Culture Courses



General English Intensive

Who is the course for?

Suitable for all staff who want an intensive course of language study. **This course is available year-round.**

Content

English fluency morning and afternoon lessons include:

- Focus on grammar and language structures
- Productive skills speaking and writing
- Listening and reading practice

+ Saturday full day trip

Requirements - Minimum A1 English language level

Communication & Culture

Who is the course for?

Suitable for all staff who want an extra focus on spoken English combined with cultural activities. **This course is available year-round.**

Content

In addition to English fluency sessions, conversation module includes:

- Conversation practice
- Role-plays and dialogues
- Colloquial language

Schedule Monday to Friday lessons 09:00-13:30 + afternoon social and cultural excursions + Saturday full day trip


