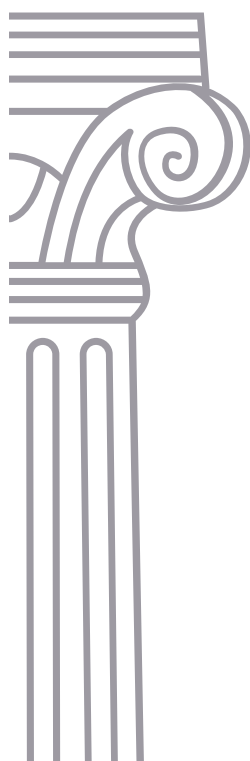

Payment & Cancellation Policy - 2025

PAYMENT POLICY

This policy applies for all of our lessons and for all of our schools (Athens, Chania & Thessaloniki).

Courses:

10% course payment -> 4 days after receiving the booking confirmation:

90% course payment -> 10 days before the student's arrival

Accommodation:

50% accommodation payment -> 4 days after receiving the booking confirmation

50% accommodation payment -> 10 days before the student's arrival

Transportation:

0% transportation payment -> 4 days after receiving the booking confirmation

100% transportation payment -> 10 days before the student's arrival

CANCELLATION POLICY

This policy applies for all of our lessons and for all of our schools (Athens, Chania & Thessaloniki). If a student wants to cancel a course, one must do so in writing. One may cancel on the following conditions, with a notice before the course begins:

Courses:

· 10% course payment -> non refundable

· 90% course payment -> refundable for a cancellation at least 10 days before the starting date. The student can also postpone & reschedule the lessons with no penalty. The new starting date should be no later than 18 months from the cancelled one. The student can also switch to individual online courses with no penalty. The number of the hours will be adjusted based on the pricing policy.

Accommodation:

The first 50% accommodation payment -> non refundable

The second 50% accommodation payment -> refundable only for a cancellation at least 10 days before the student's arrival

Transportation

· Transportation fees are not refundable

Visa Assistance and Refund Policy for International Students - 2025

- We provide guidance and support to students requiring a VISA, offering relevant advice to facilitate the process.
- Upon request, we can issue an acceptance letter for VISA purposes, provided that the student has paid the full fees in advance. This applies to bookings of a 3-month course. The fee for the acceptance letter is €100 for a digital copy and €150 for a physical copy.
- If a student's VISA application is denied, they may request a refund by submitting the official refusal letter from the Greek Consulate. In this case, a 90% refund of the paid fees will be issued, minus any applicable bank transfer fees. Alternatively, students have the option to convert their face-to-face lessons to online individual lessons.
