MUSEUM AND MONUMENTS

The Volta Temple is a museum dedicated to the inventor of the electric battery, Alessandro Volta. Museo Didattico della Seta (Silk Museum) documents the history of the silk industry in Como. The Duomo, built between XIV and XVIII centuries, is a mix of Renaissance and Gothic style. Villa Olmo, built in 1797 in the neoclassic style, hosted Napoleon Bonaparte & Giuseppe Garibaldi and other prominent figure. Villa Melzi (1808-1810) where tradition says Franz Liszt composed same of his most famous piano sonatas, enjoys a magnificent panorama over the lake. Villa Carlotta has an English-Style park; and that is just the beginning!









ABOUT MONZA

Monza is a city with different souls that reflect its history. Undoubtedly known for the Formula One Grand Prix, Monza truly offers a cross-section of history and culture that describes the different eras that it has gone through: the Longobard tradition, linked to Queen Teodolinda, and the splendour of the Hapsburgs, Napoleon and the Savoy dynasty. Monza welcomes us to a historical centre with a sober and collected atmosphere. The city is also linked to Alessandro Manzoni's literary masterpiece, I Promessi Sposi, which tells



us about Monza through the figure of the controversial Monaca di Monza.

SHOPPING AND FASHION

The main street, Via Italia, and the streets that branch off from the Duomo and the Arengario are full of ateliers, shops and workshops. Between the centre and the station is La Rinascente di Monza, one of Italy's many stores: what makes it unique is that the building that houses it originated as weaving mill and is now an attraction for citizens and tourists.

WINING AND DINING OR JUST RELAXING

Monza is also and above all synonymous with sport, outdoor life and greenery. Just a few steps away from the streets of the old town center are the more than 700 hectares of the Monza Park, established on 14 September 1805 by Emperor Napoleon with the aim of making it a model agricultural estate and hunting reserve. Inside, in addition to the famous racetrack, there are splendid neoclassical villas, farmsteads where you can shop on a zero-kilometer basis, ancient mills and an equestrian center where you can experience horse riding.

MUSEUM AND MONUMENTS

Monza, with a past as a Roman vicus and with its medieval imprint, today gives us unique treasures, linked to its rich past. The Cathedral of Monza, could be called the Sistine Chapel of Lombardy. The Museum and Treasure of the Duomo houses a collection unique in the world: from the treasure of the Lombard kings to the gifts of Napoleon I. A few steps away from the Duomo, in via Teodolinda, we recommend a visit to the Musei Civici, which contain the heritage of the Pinacoteca Civica and the Museo Storico. Also in the heart of Piazza Trento Trieste, we find the Monumento ai Caduti; the work of Enrico Pancera, it represents a victorious assault depicted by twelve mighty figures. The Arengario is the old town hall and is located in Piazza Roma, almost contiguous to the Duomo. Finally, another monument that stands out is the Ponte dei Leoni, over the Lambro river, built in 1842 on the remains of the ancient Roman Ponte d'Arena bridge.

Ce.Co.L. – CERTIFICAZIONE ITALIANO GENERALE

The Ce.Co.L. exams certify the linguistic competence for Italian for foreigners and are managed by the University of Reggio Calabria.

Ce.Co.L. exams are available for all levels and are structured to test all 4 language skills: reading comprehension, writing, speaking and listening.

These exams can be taken at our inlingua Monza school in the sessions organized directly by the school.

Both Certificate of are Italian language proficiency certificates that ratify competences and language skills. They can be used in the work field or for study purposes. These tests follow the same levels of the QCER and share the same verification methods and strict certification processes. The Ministero del Lavoro e delle Politiche Sociali recognizes the two certificates in the context of immigration and favors its diffusion to promote the knowledge of Italian language among immigrants legally residing in Italy.
