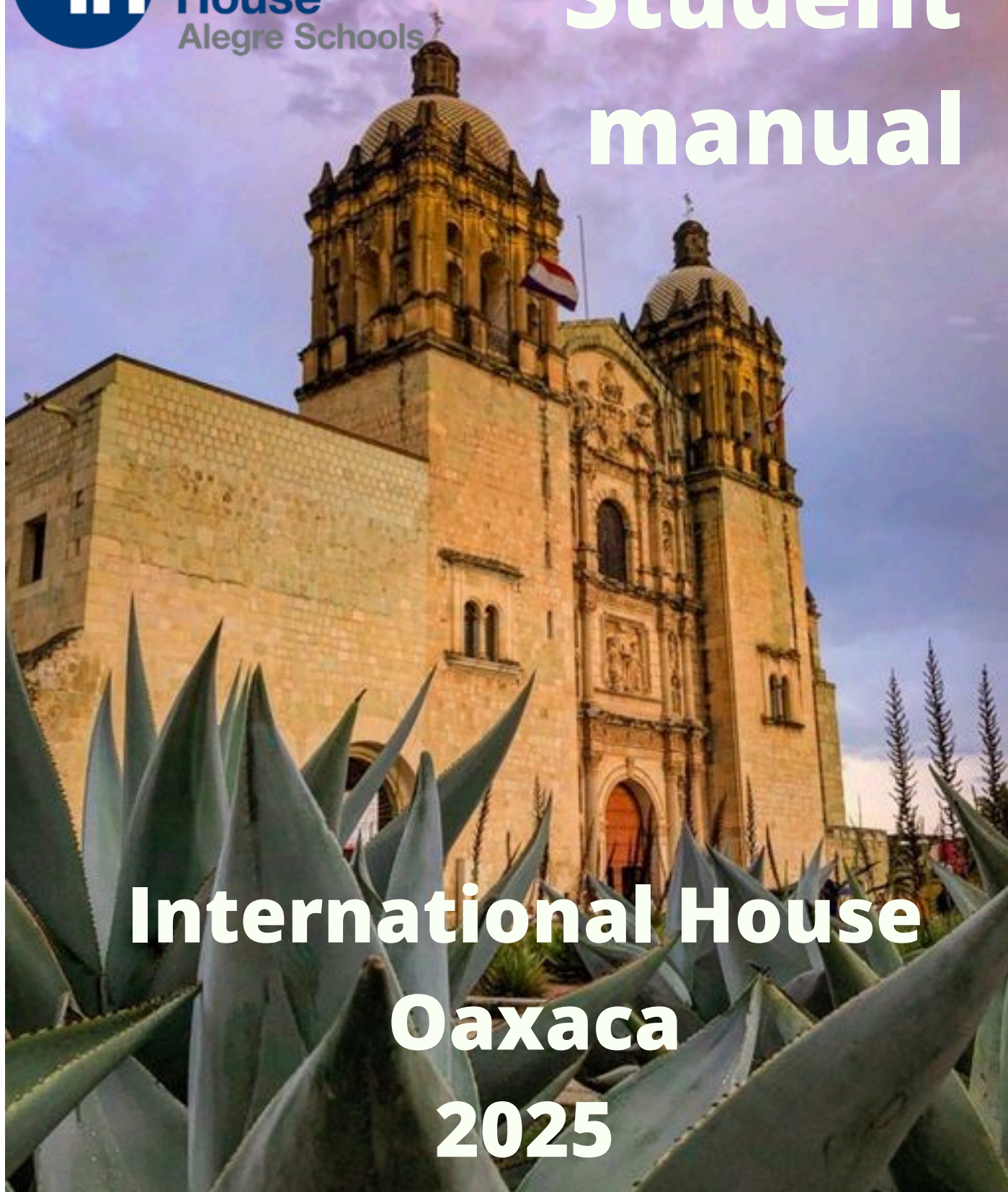

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Before you go

We understand that at times you may feel nervous when preparing for your stay in Oaxaca. There are some important things you need to know before you leave that will make your life easier when you arrive. Use your checklist on the next page to ensure that you do not forget anything and you are well prepared for the exciting times ahead of you

Pocket money

We recommend that you budget \$1,000 - \$1,500 pesos for every week of your course. This should be enough for your personal expenses, laundry, local travel and activities. You will need additional money if you plan to rent a car, take weekend trips, shopping or travel. Bring \$1,000 pesos with you in cash and the rest in debit / credit card. These should be in small denominations. As a general precaution, you should not carry around large amounts of cash.

Clothing

Students dress casually for classes. You should bring some nice clothes for going out to restaurants, museums, galleries and nightclubs, etc. You should also bring clothing for sports and outdoor activities. The climate is changeable and may be very different from your own. The typical summer temperature is 34°C and in winter 12°C.

Electric current

Standard voltage in Mexico is 120 volts. To make sure you are able to use all your electrical appliances bring an adaptor with you.



Arriving in Oaxaca



HOW TO GET FROM THE CITY TO THE AIRPORT

You should fly to Oaxaca International Airport which is just 12km of Oaxaca city. You can take a taxi or shuttle bus to the center.

Car transfer:

IH Oaxaca can arrange a private airport meeting and transfer service from the airport to your lodging in Oaxaca. On arrival at the airport students will be greeted by an International House representative who will be holding a sign with your name on it.

Cost: \$US100 for 1 person, or \$US75 per person for 2 or more people.

The prices quoted are for transfers from 08:00 to 18:00 (arrival time at the airport) If the students need a transfer before 08:00 or after 18:00, these prices will be increased by 50%. Please note that we need the arrival information at least 2 working days before arrival.

Collective van:

Catch a shuttle bus to Oaxaca from outside the National Arrivals Terminal. The bus leaves every 30 minutes from 08.00 to 20.30 and costs approximately \$200 pesos.



Taxi:

Alternatively, you can take a taxi from the airport directly to your lodging in Oaxaca. A taxi from the airport will cost around \$500 pesos (if before 08:00 or after 22:00). Note that taxi drivers only accept cash



First steps



WATER:

Drink only bottled water. Never from the faucet.



DONT FORGET



CELL PHONES:

US American cellular phones will usually work fine; European mobile phones will not usually work at all. If you are staying here a while, you might want to invest in a Mexican mobile phone. The major mobile providers in Mexico are Telcel, Movistar and AT&T Unidos. You'll be able to buy a sim card from one of their stores or convenience store.



WHERE TO CHANGE MONEY:

Small money exchange offices ("casa de cambio") are all over the town and usually open until 20:00 or 21:00. Their rates will be about 30 cents lower than the bank rate, and will be mostly the same from office to office, although may be worth looking for a better deal. There's no commission and the service is much quicker than in any bank. Whenever you exchange currencies other than those most recognized internationally, such as US Dollars (\$), Euros (€), or Sterling Pounds (£).



The school

Social and cultural activities



IH Oaxaca organize a regular program of social and cultural activities at the school, here we visit some tourist places such as:

Monte Albán:

In this activity we will take the bus that takes us to Monte Alban and returns, here we will visit the museum and later we will walk through the ruins.



The "Tule tree" :

To visit the tule tree we have two options, in the first we will rent a bicycle to be able to get to the town along the cycle path so you will have to wear comfortable clothes, sunscreen and bring water to hydrate yourself, since there are 20 kilometers in total in one flat surface. The second option is to take the local bus to get to the town.



20 de noviembre market:

In this activity we can visit the city's gastronomic market where we will enjoy roast meats, a traditional dish.





Benito Juárez market:

In this market we are going to see different stores and enjoy some activities such as tasting fresh natural waters and also typical Oaxacan ice creams.



Ethnobotanical Garden

In this place we will see a collection of plants from the different regions of the state of Oaxaca such as cacti, corn plants, beans, pumpkins, among others.



Bus tour

In this activity we will take the city's "turibus" in Spanish where we will tour the historic center of the city.



Netflix tlayudas "La chinita"

This is a nighttime activity where we will have dinner at one of the Street Food Latin American Netflix locations, some delicious tlayudas, a typical Oaxacan dish.





“Central de abastos” market

We will visit the largest market in the city, here you can learn about the local life of an Oaxacan and you can find everything you can imagine a little cheaper than normal.



Walk through the “Jalatlaco” neighborhood

We will walk around the most famous neighborhood in Oaxaca, where we will find murals full of history and culture where you can take countless photographs.



Textile museum:

This museum is one of the free museums in the city where we can see fabrics from the different regions of Oaxaca.



Museum of the cultures of Oaxaca

In this museum we can see some of the Zapotec treasures found in the ruins of Monte Albán and also objects from the different periods of history of the city and the country.



"The viewpoint of Oaxaca"

In this place we can admire the beautiful city of Oaxaca from a very nice small restaurant where we can have a beer, a fresh water or eat some of the state's typical dishes.



Our activities will be on Tuesdays and Thursdays after school.

All these activities are included in the course fee.

You don't need to pay for the tours, just the tickets or what you consume in the places to visit.

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
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
