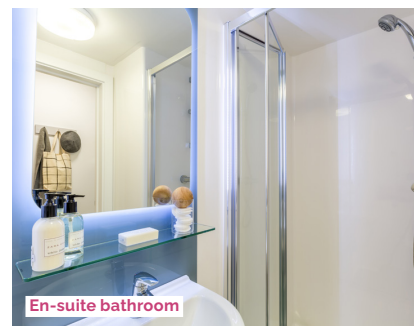

Gardens House Residence is located in the Camberwell Campus of the University of Arts London. There are various bus stops connecting you to central London within a 20-25 minute commute. All rooms are modern singles with private bathrooms arranged into flats, with 6 – 8 rooms per flat.

Each flat shares a common room/kitchen (kitchens not to be used for cooking). Please note a deposit of £50 per student is required on arrival, in case of damages. Lost keys can be charged up to £150. Towels are not included.

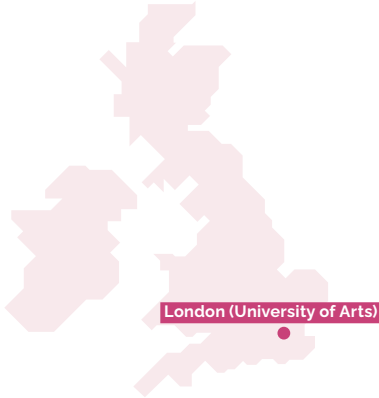
