

## **Junior Summer Courses**

## for students from 16 to 18 years

L'Italiano Porticando's Junior Summer school is a programme tailored to the needs of students aged 16 to 18. A full immersion in the Italian language, where young learners will find themselves at ease learning Italian both during their language classes at school in the mornings, and during the extracurricular activities to discover Turin and the Italian way of life in the afternoon. Day after day, they will consolidate their language skills according to their level of knowledge.

A team of professionally trained mother tongue teachers and activity leaders will take care of the students' welfare day-to-day, guaranteeing experienced teaching at school during the morning classes, as well as during all leisure activities in the afternoon.



When? The Junior Summer Courses will take place from July, 21st to Aug, 1st 2025.

The courses, in groups of min. 5 to max. 10 students, are for level A1 to level B2.



Price: 700 Euro (The price includes: 40 h of language classes, teaching materials, tutors for all afternoon activities, all entrances and transportation).



Accommodation: If needed, the school can also provide accommodation with a host family for an additional 350 Euro/week with half-board included.



Airport pick-up: The school can arrange airport transfer for additional 65 Euro.



Registration: latest until July, 4th 2025 by filling in and sending back by email the Junior courses' registration form. Each level will be confirmed if there are at least 4 registrations.
