Commonly referred to as England's second city, Manchester is known for its unique Victorian architecture, world-famous football clubs, remarkable arts and culture, and legendary music scene.

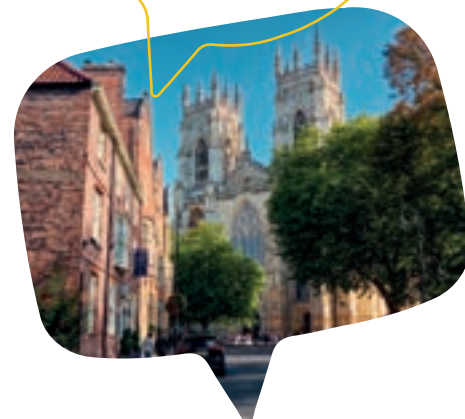
Our fun-filled General English programme includes a range of educational activities, and will give students unmissable opportunities to learn and explore, making for a truly immersive experience.

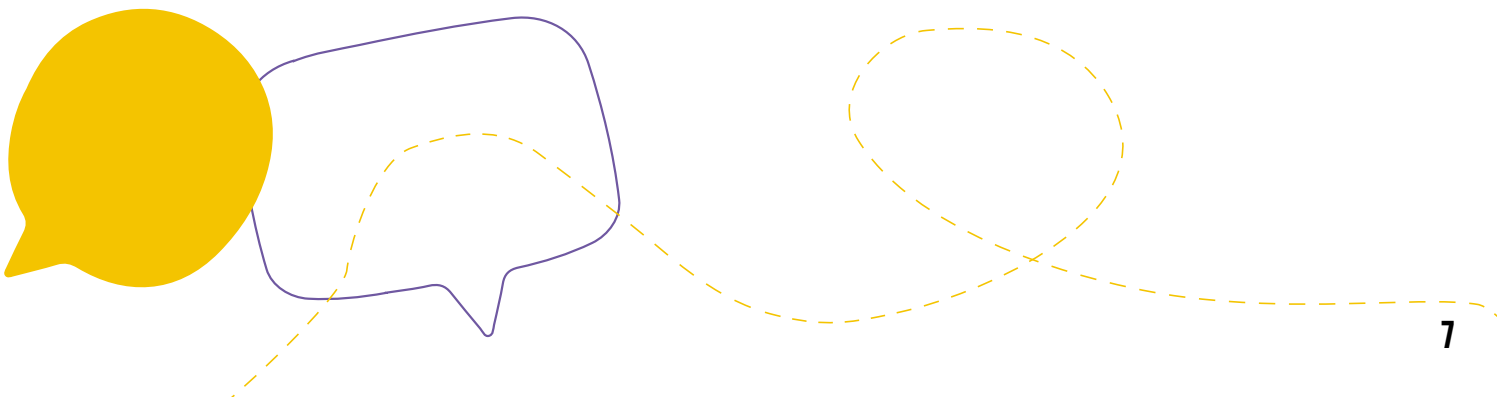

## PROGRAMME DETAILS

- Evening activities
- Full day excursion on Saturday

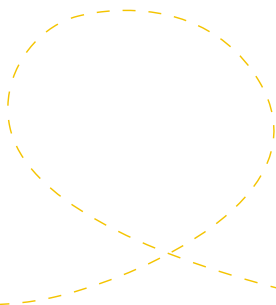
